Job Brief

CranHill is looking for volunteers to serve as a Friendship Camp Health Officer (FCHO) to partner with and serve alongside our Summer Staff Health Officer to provide valuable and experienced support to our hired in administering quality health care to our special-needs population.

Position Responsibilities

- Assist the Summer Staff Health Officer in providing adequate care for the health and medical needs of Friendship campers
- Be available and serve as a first responder to any medical/health/emergency needs or situations
- Seek to anticipate the medical needs of campers and meet those needs to the best of their ability
- Comply with CranHill safety and medical emergency procedures
- Ensure camp health procedures are safe and executed appropriately
- Participate in Friendship Camp check-in and check-out processes
- Maintain camper and colleague confidentiality
- Receive and check medical forms from campers
- Record all medication needs and assist in administration of medication based on those needs
- Assist in recording an accurate account of each accident or sickness treated
- Dispense medication as needed/prescribed
- Abide by parent-completed Medication Release instructions
- Work and serve in agreement with the CranHill rules, mission, and Biblical perspective
- Work alongside our Summer Health Officer and other Friendship staff and volunteers

Qualifications

- Passion for the mission of CranHill to transform lives into the image of Christ
- Must be available for all days of desired week(s) of service during the summer. Some flexibility in schedule may be present depending on the week desired.
- Must be licensed and carry at least 1 of the following certifications – Physician, Physician's Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, Registered Nurse, Practical Nurse, EMT, Medical First Responder, or Wilderness First Responder

Special Conditions

This is a volunteer position for 1 week in length, but multiple weeks may be available. Accommodations can be provided for the duration of the time of service (if desired) and meals will be provided while camp is in session. Friendship Camp runs from Monday morning through Friday afternoon, a Sunday arrival is also an option. The FCHO must be ready by 9:00 AM on Monday for Friendship Camp check-in.
