



CAMPER BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

This agreement establishes a shared understanding between CranHill and camper families to promote a welcoming, safe, Christ-centered, and positive camp experience. Our goal is to provide an environment where every camper can have fun, grow, build relationships, and take meaningful steps toward Jesus Christ.

CAMPER COMMITMENTS

Respect for God & Others

- I will treat all campers with kindness, dignity, and respect.
- I will not use language that is profane, demeaning, harmful, or that insults God or others.
- I will not engage in bullying, harassment, or exclusionary behavior.
- I will manage my behavior and emotions appropriately.
- I will participate in discussions and activities without disrupting or hindering others' camp experience.
- I will not steal from others, and I will respect the personal property of others.
- I will respect and follow the Biblical Standards set forth by CranHill

Respect for Staff & Leaders:

- I will be honest in my words and actions.
- I will follow directions from staff promptly and respectfully.
- I will adhere to camp guidelines, including dress code and expectations. (See [Packing List](#)).

Respect for Property & Safety

- I will care for the camp property and facilities.
- I will clean up after myself and help care for shared spaces.
- I will strive to leave each area better than I found it.
- I will not bring prohibited items (including phones, electronics, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco).
- I will remain in designated camper areas and not wander into areas I am not assigned to be in.
- I will follow all safety instructions.

PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENTS

- I will review this agreement with my child before camp.
- I will talk with my child to set behavior goals and will follow up with him/her after camp to debrief the experience.
- I will be available during the camp session for communication if needed.
- I will partner with CranHill staff in addressing behavioral concerns.
- I accept responsibility for transportation if my child is dismissed from camp.
- I understand that dismissal due to behavior will not result in a refund.
- I will communicate any relevant behavioral or emotional needs in advance.

CRANHILL COMMITMENTS

Care & Environment

- We will provide safe, high-quality, Christ-centered programming.
- We will treat each camper as an individual made in the image of God.
- We will foster a welcoming environment for campers from all backgrounds.
- We will maintain a structured, distraction-free setting that supports growth and community to enhance collaboration, engagement, and understanding.
- We will support parents in their child-raising efforts, listen, and help when appropriate.

Biblical Standards

- We will operate in accordance with our Mission, Core Values, and Statement of Faith. (See our mission and values [HERE](#)) (See our Statement of Faith [HERE](#))
- We will maintain behavioral and relational expectations consistent with Biblical teaching.
- We will house campers according to their biological sex, and that will be how campers participate in our programs.
- CranHill does not accommodate requests for name or gender identity changes that conflict with these convictions.
- Campers are expected to respect these standards and avoid behavior or discussions that disrupt the camp environment or create confusion for others.
- CranHill staff will consistently demonstrate kindness, respect, and compassion toward every camper while upholding these standards.

LIMITATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

While CranHill takes all reasonable measures to provide a safe environment, participation in camp activities involves inherent risks. By signing this agreement, parents/guardians acknowledge these risks and agree to support CranHill policies and decisions made in the best interest of the camp community.

CAMPER BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

DISCIPLINE & DISMISSAL POLICY

CranHill reserves the right to bypass progressive discipline steps when deemed necessary for the safety or well-being of campers or staff.

Immediate Dismissal (No Refund) May Occur For:

- Sexual misconduct or harassment
- Physical aggression or threats of harm
- Bullying or intimidation
- Use of discriminatory or harmful language
- Possession of prohibited items
- Repeated or severe disruption of the camp environment
- Other behaviors deemed inappropriate for the camp environment

Progressive Discipline (When Appropriate)

- 1) Verbal warning and consultation with leadership staff (*if necessary*)
- 2) Parent notification and behavior plan
- 3) Dismissal from camp
